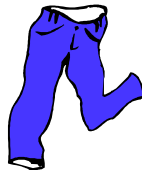
Ah, that time so dreaded among camp parents—packing time! To help you prepare your future CHAMPION(S) for camp, we've tried to make packing as organized and as simple as possible. On these two pages, you'll find our recommended camp packing list. If possible, pack clothing in a trunk and a duffle bag. You can use the checkoff boxes while you pack for camp!

IN THE TRUNK, WE RECOMMEND:

CLOTHING



- 10 pair of underwear
- 10 pair of socks
- 3 pairs of jeans/pants
- 1 sweatshirt
- 10 t-shirts
- 1 long sleeved white t-shirt for sun protection



- 1 plain white t-shirt or polo (for vespers)
- 6 pair of shorts
- 2 swim suits
- 1 brimmed cap
- 1 casual outfit for dances/special events
- 2 pair of pajamas/sleepwear
- 1 t-shirt & pair of shorts that can get



(Reminder : muscle shirts are not allowed in the fillin station) **TRASHED!**

Just so you know, our laundry service washes each camper's clothing and linens once a week!

PERSONAL ITEMS

(pack in a separate pouch or container if possible)

- 2 toothbrushes
- toothpaste
- floss
- shampoo
- antibacterial soap and soapdish



- waterproof sunscreen (SPF 15+)
- comb or brush
- lotion
- lip ointment (with sunblock)
- extra pair of glasses or contact lenses



SHOES



- 2 pairs of sneakers or athletic shoes
- 1 pair of sandals or aquasocks
- 1 pair of cowboy boots (MANDATORY if taking horseback)

IN THE DUFFLE BAG, WE RECOMMEND:

LINENS

- 2 fitted sheets (bunk or twin)
- 2 flat sheets (bunk or twin)
- 1 pillow
- 2 pillow cases
- 1 light blanket



- 1 sleeping bag (for overnight trip)
- 2 large beach towels
- 2 regular towels
- 2 washcloths
- 2 laundry bags **WITH NAME CLEARLY ON THE OUTSIDE**

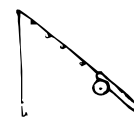
MISCELLANEOUS

- nose plugs
- flashlight
- batteries
- stationery
- stamps
- pens or pencils
- outfits for theme dances/parties (We'll reveal these in the Camper Camp Guide that we'll mail out in April!)



SPORTS EQUIPMENT (optional)

- tennis racket
- baseball glove
- water gun (for self-defense)
- fishing pole



OPTIONAL

- swim goggles
- camera and film (No digital cameras)
- sunglasses
- ear plugs
- canteen or water bottle
- playing cards
- books



- battery-operated fans
- props/costumes for skits and Talent Show (musical instruments, tap shoes, juggling balls)
- items to make your cabin like home (photos of family, etc.)



ESPECIALLY FOR 1ST-TIME FAMILIES--this is a recommended packing list only. You know your child(ren) better than we do. If you decide "my daughter will never use 10 t-shirts, but she goes through socks like crazy," that's great! Pack fewer shirts and more socks. After your camper's first summer as a CHAMPION, you'll have a lot better idea of the necessities!
